


1800 BRAKE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Uninstall the 5" wheels.
- 2. Install the brake (1-B29). Install using a washer and cotter pin on each end.
- 3. Install 1-A007 and 1-A023 in the lower threaded bracket. This makes the adjustable stop for the brake.
- 4. Attach the brake rod (1-B29-5) to the brake using the Yoke (1-B29-6), 1-A005, and 1-A021.
- 5. Attach the brake rod (1-B29-5) to the brake handle (1-B34), using a cotter pin.
- 6. Attach the brake handle (1-B34) to the upper bracket with 1-A062 and 1-A021.
- 7. The brake is now installed.
- 8. Reinstall the 5" wheels.
- 9. You will need to spend a few moments adjusting the stop for the brake to work correctly.
- 10. Once the brake is adjusted, tighten 1-A023 to lock 1-A007 into place.



The brake supplied on Dutro Companys Brute trucks is only for breaking over the load when stopped on a level surface. It is not to be used as a brake for stopping, slowing or retaining the unloaded or loaded unit on either flat or sloped surfaces.
